Dear School District Superintendents and Charter School Operators:


Thanks to the School Board of Miami-Dade County, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) recently became aware of content within the Edgenuity/Imagine Learning Purpose Prep social emotional learning curriculum that, upon preliminary review, appears contrary to Florida law. Districts and charter schools may be using this curriculum as part of their teaching and learning process.

If districts or charter schools are using this curriculum in any way, I implore you to conduct a thorough review to ensure all content is compliant with Florida law. Edgenuity/Imagine Learning's divisive and discriminatory content branded as "social emotional learning (SEL)" has no place in Florida's classrooms.

To be clear, we are communicating to all public school districts and individual public charter schools that it is incumbent upon you to make certain that all materials are consistent with State Board of Education Rule and Florida Statutes. Schools should immediately cease using any materials that conflict with Florida law.

As Commissioner of Education, I will always be committed to protecting Florida's students while ensuring they have access to the highest quality materials and educational opportunities. Thank you for your dedication to ensuring the success of Florida's students and your prompt attention to this matter.
